Purpose:	decision making passing skills getting open in limited space defending smartly	
Procedure:	split team into 2 teams line players on the rag lines alternating team members along each line put 2 players from each each team between the lines give ball to one team and they are on offence, other team on D team on O must pass to team mate on line (no one can check or interfere with players on lines) if pass is successful, O players must work to get open and receive a return pass, players must stay within the lines if ball is dropped or intercepted, other team is on offence players play for 1 minute at a time and then coach changes team gets a point for a completed pass out and back into playing area play to 10 or 15 depending on skill
